I wish to commend the ASTC DFW Pro Bono Initiative for their invaluable pro bono assistance of Human Rights Initiative of North Texas.

Since 1999, Human Rights Initiative of North Texas has been one of the leading agencies in the country that helps immigrants seeking asylum in the United States. HRI is the only agency in North Texas that provides free legal representation to those individuals who have suffered human rights abuses in their homelands and have credible asylum cases. Our clients are persecuted Christians from Egypt and Iran, pro-democracy activists from Ethiopia and women fleeing female genital mutilation from Guinea. Many of our clients are torture survivors, speak English as a second language and are suffering from post-traumatic stress disorder.

Through our pro bono model, we provide free legal services through an extensive network of lawyers. Many of our lawyers are not immigration lawyers and several of the volunteers are not trial lawyers. It has been extremely valuable for a pro bono case to receive the benefit of the decades of experience of a professional trial consultant.

We have been thrilled that the ASTC DFW Pro Bono Initiative has been providing pro bono trial consultant services. The most critical aspect of the client's case is to be able to testify to the things that happened to them credibly.
